Helpful Tips: When you interact with them make sure you introduce yourself first. Then ask them a question to get to know them better. Be prepared to share something about yourself. Finally, make sure you thank them from their time.

For example, after Mass you see Father Robert.

Hello Father Robert. My name is Sue, and I am in 8th grade. I was wondering if you ever played a sport when you were in school? I play soccer in the summer, and I really enjoy it. (After he answers your question) Thank you for sharing. Have a great day.

Additional tips, if you need it: Take a moment right now to think about what you really want to know. Do not ask a question you do not care about. The point is to get to know them better, you may find out you have some things in common.

Here are some suggestions to get your started – you do not need to use any of them. Be creative and come up with your own.

- What is your Favorite food / restaurant?
- What is your Favorite childhood memory?
- What is your favorite mode of transportation: plane, train, automobile, bike, or boat?
- What has been your favorite vacation?
- Where did you grow up or go to school?
- Who was your best friend growing up – and do you keep in touch?
- What is one favorite activity from childhood you wish you could do now?
- What is your favorite app on your phone you cannot live without?
