Opening Prayer: Say the Apostles Creed prayer with your child. I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. Last week in the classroom, the children learned about the Epiphany, when the Three Wise Men came to bring gifts to the newborn king, Jesus. This week we are going to use the Sunday scriptures for January 14th to guide our learning.

## **Lesson:** Jesus and his Disciples
