

October 25, 2023 At-Home Lesson

Grade 4

Begin your lesson with the opening prayer, The Lord's Prayer. Make the sign of the cross.

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Lesson: Today you will be studying Scripture and the Lord's Prayer to learn how we are called to follow Jesus.

First, read the story of Jairus's daughter- Mark 5: 21-43. Think about and discuss these questions:

Why do you think Jesus gave the daughter back to her family?

What questions might the daughter have after Jesus brought her back from the dead?

Take time to thank God for giving you life.

Next, read the story of the Paralyzed Man- Luke 5: 17-26.

Think about and discuss these questions:

What did Jesus do for this man?

When do you ask Jesus for forgiveness?

Then, watch the video about "The Lord's Prayer". Pay close attention to the meanings of each line. Do we ask for

forgiveness in the Lord's Prayer? Are we called to follow Jesus in this prayer?
