 - O Dear Jesus, as we light the candle(s) on this Advent wreath, may the light of your presence bring joy to our hearts. Bless our family and our friends, and be with all those who are in need this holiday season. Amen.
- <u>Lastly</u>, complete the Advent promises worksheet for Week 1. Use this sheet each week to prepare for Jesus's birth.

Conclusion: Continuing your Advent Prayer

- Advent begins on Sunday, December 3, 2023. Use the attached weekly prayers to journey through the Advent season as a family. If you already have Advent prayers for your wreath, please feel free to use yours.
