

October 25, 2023 At-Home Lesson

Grade 5

Begin with an opening prayer- The Lord's Prayer.

Make the sign of the cross.

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Lesson: This week you will be focusing on the Sacrament of Baptism. You will need your Bible to read scripture.

First, read Matthew 3:1-17- The Preaching of John the Baptist and the Baptism of Jesus. Imagine you are at Jesus's Baptism. Jesus then comes over to talk to you. Think about and discuss these questions:

What do you think Jesus would say to you?

What would you want to say to him?

Next, watch this video about why we baptize as Catholics.

After the video, share your thoughts with your family about Baptism. Ask to see some of your Baptismal items– white garment, Baptismal candle, pictures, etc.
