**Review Data from Mass Time Survey:** Mass times survey results as follows: 7am & 9am – 98 votes; 7:30 & 9:30-87 votes; 8 & 10-131 votes; 8:30 & 10:30 – 86 votes. ## **Committee Reports:**

- 1) Finance Council: Will VanRossum Our current budget has about a \$47k deficit. Finance is currently working to get an overview in the bulletin in July for the fiscal year. Would like to have cash accounts set up so people can just come worship and celebrate!
- 2) **School Advisory: Leah VandenBosch** Currently still have 2 open positions to fill for next school year. Need a 3k Aide and an 8<sup>th</sup> grade teacher/Middle school teacher. Also talked about retention for 3k, 4k and middle school years. Deacon Peter Gard with the Diocese is willing to come take a look at our school, to discuss with Mrs. Lutz and Father Judah.
- adult pilgrimage on May 29<sup>th</sup> to St. Joan of Arc and St. Josephat. Our Thursday morning women's group will continue thru the summer months. The widow/widowers' dinner held on April 22<sup>nd</sup> with St. Ed's went very well. The St. Carlos room has been a wonderful meeting room for our middle and high school youth groups! Love Begins Here mission will be held here at St. Nicholas. We have 12 from St. Nicholas Parish and 45 from other parishes attending the mission! We will be bringing 21 high schoolers to attend the Steubenville Conference July 11-13. Our last RE gathering was on April 9<sup>th</sup> with another successful year with 223 young disciples. First Communion was held the weekend of April 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> with 36 young first communicants. Our RE catechist dinner was held at Buzz's where we received good feedback for ongoing discipleship for the parish. Current registration numbers for next year's RE program is 162 students/110 families.
- 4) **Worship: Carl Peterson** Pentecost, Holy Trinity and Corpus Christi have Jesus' blood. Ann Thelan has retired from her job and has quite a few weddings to fill in for music. This year's Easter masses; Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday, had quite a few changes from years past. Will be discussed on how we want
