Meeting was called to order at 6:34 PM.

**Opening Prayer:** Jim Newhouse led the opening prayer.

Review of the minutes from the April meeting: Motion to accept was made by Karen Court and

**Pastoral comments:** Fr. Judah is happy to be working with our committee. We welcomed Fr.

Judah and each committee member gave an introduction.

#### **Old Business:**

**New Lectionary:** Jim gave an update to Fr. Judah about the need to replace our current missals. Fr. Judah explained that the revised translations are not available yet. We are dependent on the Church Scholars to complete this work before the new lectionary can be updated. We will continue to repair our existing missals as needed to extend the life until new missals are purchased.

**Ministries Scheduler (MSP).** Fr Robert was the administrator of MSP and we are wondering how it is working since he has left. Jill and Nikki are working on learning the APP, however they have limited time to spend on it. Vicky Wolf offered to help do administration of the MSP app; Karen will let Jill know. There was also a possible issue with people being in multiple ministries that we need to make sure it works appropriately for.

#### **New Business:**

**Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary** is August 15. Mass times are Friday at 8:15am and 5:45pm. Musicians, Cantor, Sacristans and Readers are scheduled. If an EMHC is needed, our committee should help Fr. Judah distribute the Eucharist.

**Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) commissioning.** Jim explained the commissioning was completed at a mass in June, but unfortunately not all EMHC could attend. Another commissioning mass needs to be scheduled. Jim will work with Fr. Judah to get this scheduled. Also, the list of EMHC that were commissioned were not recorded. Jim will send an

email to EMHC to find out who were commissioned. Also, Fr Judah would like an EMHC to return the Eucharist to the Tabernacle after communion. Jim will include this change to the EMHC in the email he is sending to them.

Jim announced that Deacon Don Newhouse family will be purchasing this piano for St Nicholas in remembrance of him. It will be put in the music room in the school.

August trial of adding a Sunday at 5:45pm mass. Fr. Judah reported at the first mass there were over 100 parishioners in attendance. An email has been sent to all people helping with ministries asking to sign up to help at these masses. Since the attendance is high, we will look to add this evening mass during the summer next year.

**Worship Committee Member Needed.** Unfortunately, Ron Koepke needs to resign from the worship committee. We are in need of a new member. We should prayerfully consider possible candidates to our next meeting. We would like to ask an usher to attend so they are represented on the committee.

**Advent Booklet.** Advent booklets need to be ordered in September in order to be here for Advent. We reviewed some sample books and the committee recommended the book "Slowing Down to the Speed of Joy" by Matthew Kelly. Jim will coordinate with the parish office to get the book ordered.
